How do I install the PD-1?

Most important is that Protools machine control S/W must be fitted. The template instructions are a good start on how to setup Protools

Can we use an already installed Keyspan USA28XG (422-USB converter, which works fine with other 422 devices). Are there any known issues with this?

You can use keyspan, but must use the machine emulation cable or a tx-rx invert cable as the PD-1 is a controller and Protools is the device.

How do I install the USB422?

To use our usb422 you will need to use a driver from our website

If you use the usb422 then the flashing LEDS will help diagnose any problems. Use the "Input" port-A

Once connected the PD-1 will display the machine name (Protools) and current timecode position.
